## Cedar LNG is proposing to build and operate an LNG facility in the traditional territory of the Haisla Nation.

With major development milestones achieved, including receipt of all major regulatory approvals, Cedar LNG is preparing for construction, which could commence as early as May 2024, starting with tree clearing and rough grading activities at our proposed marine terminal near Kitimat.
