

As Cedar LNG progresses with construction, we are committed to sharing updates about our activities with the community. As part of construction activities, including pipeline construction, controlled blasting activities are anticipated over several months within the approved project footprint area. Please see below for more information.

- What: Controlled blasting activities are planned as part of preliminary pipeline construction to prepare the Cedar LNG Pipeline right-of-way (ROW) for construction, in accordance with provincial and federal regulations. Learn more about pipeline construction **here**.
- When: Starting in late April and continuing at various intervals until late August. Blasting activities will occur between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Where: Controlled blasting activities will occur along sections of the ROW that are west of Haisla Boulevard, Alcan Road, and the Bish Creek Service Road. This work is scheduled to start at the southern end of the ROW near the Cedar LNG marine terminal and will then extend to multiple locations simultaneously over the coming weeks and months. There are no permanent residential areas located within the vicinity of the ROW and as such, it is not expected that these activities will result in detectable sound or vibration beyond the construction area. 
