**AMENDMENT #2 (AMENDMENT) TO
ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATE #E23-01**

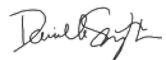
WHEREAS:

- A. On March 13, 2023, the Minister of Environment and Climate Change Strategy and the Minister of Energy, Mines, and Low Carbon Innovation issued Environmental Assessment Certificate #E23-01(Certificate) to Cedar LNG Partners (GP) Ltd.
- B. The Certificate authorized Cedar LNG Partners (GP) Ltd. to construct and operate the Cedar LNG Project (Project) within the District of Kitimat, British Columbia. The Project is a liquefied natural gas (LNG) export facility with a capacity to liquefy up to and including 400 million standard cubic feet per day (11.33 million cubic metres per day) of natural gas to produce LNG for export.
- C. On April 9, 2025, the Deputy Chief Executive Assessment Officer issued Amendment #1 to the Certificate to allow for an alternative power transmission line route, a power distribution line, and expansion of the marine terminal area, under Section 32(3) of the Act.
- D. On March 24, 2026, the British Columbia Energy Regulator (BCER) recommended to the EAO an amendment to the Certificate under Section 32(5)(a) of the Act to allow the use of two temporary work areas.
- E. Pursuant to Section 4 of the Act (2018), the Chief Executive Assessment Officer has delegated to the undersigned, powers and duties under the Act, including the power to amend certificates.

NOW THEREFORE,

I amend the Certificate as follows:

- 1. Section 2.1 in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate is amended as shown in Attachment A.
- 2. Figure 4 in Attachment B to this Amendment is added to the Certified Project Description

Section 2.1 in the Certified Project Description in Schedule A of the Certificate is amended from:

Temporary work areas within the Facility Area, Transmission Line Corridor, distribution powerline right-of-way, or on private property that are required only for Construction include:

- a) Laydown areas and temporary workspaces;
- b) Borrow pits; and,
- c) Disposal areas for overburden, excess rock and topsoil.

To

Temporary work areas within the Facility Area, Transmission Line Corridor, distribution powerline right-of-way, on private property, or at the locations outlined in Figure 4 that are required only for Construction include:

- a) Laydown areas and temporary workspaces;
- b) Borrow pits; and,
- c) Disposal areas for overburden, excess rock and topsoil
